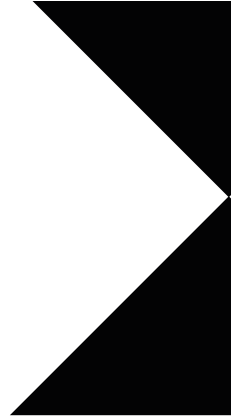

OUR HISTORY



The International Soccer club has a long, rich history dating back to the late 1950's. Established in 1959 by a handful of Italian immigrants, we have worked hard at establishing our reputation as being the most successful soccer club in the Limestone Coast Football Association. We have achieved this through junior development, and by forging an inclusive team culture.

Based at Casadio Park, Bay Road, Moorak, the venue is dedicated to the memory of a club member's son, Lieutenant Anthony Casadio RAN, who tragically lost his life whilst serving Australia during the Vietnam War.

We pride ourselves in continually striving for excellence on and off the field. Our competitive spirit translates into respect for our community, by initiating and supporting events such as the Indigenous round, ANZAC Day commemoration and local charities such as Foodbank and Spare Ya Change 4 Kids.

We always look to improve our club and our facilities. Through being awarded a substantial grant, matched in kind by our Major Sponsor Versace Home Builders, we have upgraded our sporting facilities including new non-binary change rooms, new and upgraded LUX lighting for pitches, and new fences. We also have a range of club merchandise for purchase along with great bar and canteen facilities.

We have invested in the future of our club by implementing a coaching structure with both senior and junior coaching coordinators ensuring smooth transition for players through the grades. We are committed to providing our coaches with the required FFA accredited training to develop our junior and senior men's and women's teams, and other training and certifications relevant to their roles.

Our second pitch was opened in 2021, and we hosted the LCFA Grand Final that same year. For the first time, all eight grand final games were able to be played on the same day at the one location, across the two pitches.

In addition to the men's and women's senior and junior competitions, we have teams in the MiniRoos under 6-11 age group competition held early in the year. The social Inter 7-a-side summer competition is popular and our bocce competition also has a keen following.
